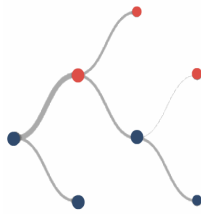

Frequently Asked Questions

What is Freshman Seminar?

Freshman Seminar is a transition course for ninth graders to prepare them for success in high school, post-secondary education and careers. Students focus on learning more about themselves and their interests and aptitude as well as learning study skills, life skills, employability/professional skills, and career knowledge.

Is this a blended course?

Yes, this course is designed to be used as a teacher-led classroom course, a self-paced online student course or a combination of both.

What is included with the course?

This course includes six (6) college and career readiness lessons, aligned to a college and career readiness rubric, and eighty (80) distinct career pathways. Purchase of this freshman seminar course comes with up to three (3) hours virtual support and guidance.

Which college and career readiness lessons are included?

This course includes college and career readiness lessons in the following areas: attendance and punctuality, communication, ethics, interpersonal effectiveness, personal presentation, and quality and commitment.

Can this course be used for middle school students?

Yes, this course is adaptable for use in middle school.

Is this a yearlong course or a semester course?

This course can be adapted for use based on your preferred timeframe.
